QSFT Scholarship Terms and Conditions

General

The Queensland School of Film and Television (QSFT) is offering one (1) 18 months scholarship for the Diploma of Screen and Media, starting Semester 1, 2023.

The scholarship is for a 18 months period (3 semesters), 15 units course. The scholarship cannot be transferred or extended. If the student is unable to complete 5 subjects per semester, and wishes to complete the Diploma past the 18 month period, the remaining subjects will be at the student's own cost.

The Scholarship is not redeemable for cash.

Eligibility

To be eligible you need to:

- Received a Letter of Offer for the course
- 2022 High School graduate.
- Be an Australian Citizen/resident.
- Provide Expression of Interest (up to 300 words).
- Provide a portfolio of work.
- Undertaken media related subjects.

Applications for the scholarship will only be accepted if you have met all the above criteria.

Application Process

The QSFT School Board will assess all applications against certain criteria.

Criteria will be based on:

- Met eligibility requirements.
- Quality of Portfolio.
- Passion for film and television.
- Goals.
- Career objectives.

After the first stage of assessment, applicants will be contacted via mail the outcome of their application. Applicants who passed the first stage will be invited to attend an interview.

Following the interview process, the School Board will make a final assessment. The scholarship will be granted to the Applicant deemed (by the board) most suitable. The School Board's decision is final.

In the event the selected student is unable to accept the scholarship, the School Board will offer the scholarship to another applicant.

Applicants will be notified by mail about the progress of their application.

Academic performance

The scholarship position is on-going and performance based. Throughout the course the student needs to:

- Attend at least 80% of classes.
- Submit assessment on time in full.
- 80% pass rate (assessment).
- Participate in th School events as required
- Provide minimum 1 x showreel per semester during the course of study
- Follow QSFT policies and procedures (e.g. Code of Conduct)

If the student fails to meet the above, they will need to meet with QSFT representatives to discuss performance and come to solutions. If no solution is reached or the student continues to perform poorly, QSFT has the right to withdraw the scholarship at any time.

At the beginning of each semester the student will need to meet with QSFT representatives to discuss the previous semester's performance.

If a student withdraws their enrollment during the 18 month period, the remaining time of the scholarship will be forfeited at the discretion of the School Board.

Termination

In the event that these terms and conditions are not adhered to, the QSFT School Board has the right to withdraw the Scholarship at anytime.

To retain your scholarship, you must:

- Maintain enrolment.
- Maintain your performance (attendance & assessment).
- Adhere to QSFT's policies and procedures.
- Adhere to the Scholarship's Terms and Conditions.
